Key Stage 1 readiness

During the EYFS pupils will:

- Explore drawing and painting with hands, paint brushes and other objects
- Explore drawing and painting on a variety of materials (paper, tables, ground, etc.)
- Explore colour and mixing colours using paint and other media
- Explore drawing lines and shapes to draw buildings and other objects
- Explore drawing and painting by observing people and objects around them
- Explore using materials and objects to create a picture, objects or sculpture
- Explore some well-known artists
